CA TEACHING CREDENTIAL INFORMATION

To complete requirements for a preliminary Single Subject (Secondary) California teaching credential, students who pursue the concentration in English Education must pass the CSET Examination in English (including Composition and Rhetoric, Literature, and Linguistics) to demonstrate Subject Matter Competency and complete the Professional Preparation coursework and other items as required by the commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC).

GENERAL ADVISING TIPS

- Typically, the higher the number, the harder the class.
- Plan FE courses so you have a good balance of content/workload.
- Registration clearance is required each semester, so meet your advisor and get cleared. Come with a plan.
- Registration times are assigned based on the number of units you have completed. Be prepared to register and come with back up options if certain courses are already full.
- Find a registration buddy who has had success with registration before. It's helpful in case you have any issues!
- Transfer Students: Verify you have completed WRI 1010 and MTH 1013 by Junior year.
- Identify and schedule courses that are limited by semester/year.
